MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

Permit Status Descriptions:

- **Individual:** people who hold a Michigan permit for wildlife rehabilitation in their own name, signed by the DNR permit officer.
- **Sub-permittee:** people whose names and facility information appears on someone else's permit.
- **Volunteer:** people who go to either a permitted or sub-permitted person's facility to provide help with the wildlife rehabilitation work. They may or may not interact with wild animals in care but do not take them home.
- **Supporter:** people who support the mission of wildlife rehabilitation and the preservation of wildlife habitat.
- **No Permit:** people who are in the process of applying or have applied for a wildlife rehabilitation permit but have not yet received it.
- **Other:** people who hold a wildlife rehabilitation permit in a state other than Michigan or outside the United States; also veterinarians, wildlife mobilization or nuisance control.
